Cliff Trail: 2.3 mile loop, trailhead is located behind Harpswell Town Office, 263 Mountain Road

Mitchell Field: 1.6 mile loop and woods trails. Lots of parking! 1410 Harpswell Neck Road

Little Ponds Preserve: 22-acre preserve with 9/10-mile loop trail, parking at 206 Bethel Point Road

Devil's Back East: 1 mile loop, trailhead is on south end of parking lot, 1203 Harpswell Islands Rd.

Devil's Back West: 1 mile loop, trailhead is across street from parking, 1203 Harpswell Islands Rd.

Otter Brook: 1.7 miles, trailhead is located off parking lot, 429 Harpswell Neck Road.
